6.3. Solicitation and Fundraising on Library Property

Olathe Public Library (OPL) cannot allow any of the following activities on library property because they may interfere with customers' use or enjoyment of the library:

- Solicitation
- Advertising
- Promotion
- Vending
- Peddling
- Product sampling

OPL does not endorse, sponsor, or support products, services, persons, or groups unless related to library service or management.

OPL occasionally receives requests from customers or staff to conduct or endorse fundraising events or to provide public space for donation collection boxes. The library does not sponsor or endorse the fundraising activities of other organizations, although periodically it may cooperate with local community charitable groups or service clubs to support community endeavors. Staff fundraising activities directed solely at staff may be conducted in staff offices or lunch areas.

All OPL-specific fundraising will be conducted under the auspices and/or permission of the Library Foundation and the Friends of the Library.
