### 7. Library Code of Behavior

#### 7.1. Guidelines for Customer Behavior

Olathe Public Library (OPL) intends to maintain a positive atmosphere throughout its library buildings and property. To ensure that everyone can enjoy our libraries, library staff will enforce guidelines for customer behavior on library property as well as any applicable law which includes federal, state, local or other applicable law (see <u>Olathe Municipal Code, Public Offense Code Title 9</u>).

#### 7.1.1 Prohibited Behaviors

In keeping with OPL's commitment to customer service and the provision of a safe and inviting atmosphere, the following guidelines explain prohibited behavior:

Engaging in any behavior in violation of federal, state, local, or other applicable law, or library policy is prohibited.

Animals	Entering library with animals, insects, or other living organisms,
	except for "guide dogs, hearing assistance dogs, and service dogs"
	(Olathe Municipal Code 9.07.330)
Attire	Entering library without a shirt or other covering of the upper
	body or without footwear.
Computer Use	Using library computer workstations in an unacceptable manner.
	Including, but not limited to:
	<ul> <li>Listening to sound without the use of headphones or</li> </ul>
	earbuds
	<ul> <li>Eating food, including small snacks</li> </ul>
	<ul> <li>Drinking from containers without a spill-proof lid</li> </ul>
	<ul> <li>Deleting, damaging, or destroying any library computer</li> </ul>

	<ul> <li>Accessing or displaying obscene material on library</li> </ul>

Damage	Damaging or attempting to damage library materials or library

Disruptive Behavior	Interfering with use of library by customers, or with library staff's

	<ul> <li>Behaviors that, by sight, sound, or bodily gestures, are</li> </ul>
	intrusive to other customers' concentration and enjoyment
	of facilities, services, programs, and materials.
Drink	Using containers with secure lids and spill-proof lids is required.
Food	Eating food, except for small, pre-packaged snacks, in library is
	prohibited, except in the café areas, the Downtown Library
	Copeland Rooftop Terrace, or while attending a library-facilitated
	program or event or private rental event.
Hygiene/Odor	Entering library with bodily hygiene and/or odor (including
	perfumes) that impairs the library's clean and sanitary
	environment intended for customers' enjoyment of the library
	and creates a nuisance for customers.
Obstruction	Interfering, obstructing, or blocking passageways, including, but
	not limited to, aisles or exits.
Personal Belongings	Leaving personal belongings unattended. Library is not
	responsible for lost or stolen items.
	<ul> <li>Personal belongings must not take up excess space,</li> </ul>
	impede access to services and materials or cause a safety
	hazard.
	<ul> <li>Unattended personal belongings will be collected, and an</li> </ul>
	effort will be made to identify and contact the owner. If not

	claimed within a reasonable amount of time, items will be discarded.
Sexual Misconduct	Engaging in sexual misconduct in library, including, but not limited to exposure, masturbation, sexual harassment, offensive touching, and sexual solicitation.
Smoking	Smoking or using tobacco products, including electronic cigarettes or vapes, on library property, except for the designated smoking area (see <u>7.4 Non- Smoking Policy</u> )
Theft	Theft or attempted theft, or destruction or attempted destruction, damage or attempted damage of library materials or property or the personal property of library customers or staff.
Unattended Child	Leaving child unattended (see <u>7.2 Unattended Child</u> )
Unauthorized Access	Entering or remaining in library before or after posted hours of service, being in unauthorized areas of library, or refusing to leave library when requested during emergency situations, evacuation exercises, or after engaging in prohibited behaviors.
Use of Facilities	Library facilities, equipment, and furnishings are to be used solely for their intended purposes. Customers are prohibited from jumping, climbing, or engaging in any behavior that may damage library property or pose a safety risk to themselves or others.  Sleeping, bathing, washing clothes, preparing meals or food or soliciting in library or on library property is prohibited.
Wheeled Recreational	Using skateboards or inline skates on library property (Olathe
Equipment	Municipal Code 10.01.136).
Wheeled Vehicles	Bringing wheeled vehicles in library or leaving wheeled vehicles in unauthorized areas on library property.
